We have had a great deal of success in local and county athletics competitions, we have won a local area football tournament and we have performed exceptionally well in cross country meets.
How has your school's spending increased pupil PE and sport activity levels?	We have identified less active children and, with specialist coaches in and outside of lessons, we have increased participation.
How has your school's spending increased school sport participation?	We have entered a greater number of School Games events this year; as a result, we achieved the gold award for the first time in five years. We've also had specialist athletics coaching which resulted in excellent local and county athletics performances.
How has your school's spending increased pupil participation in extra-curricular activities?	We have offered football, netball, multi-skills, running and yoga clubs this year.
How has your school's spending increased staff participation in extra-curricular activities and school sports competitions?	As we have entered more competitions, more staff have had the opportunity to attend school sports competitions with pupils.
How has your school's spending improved swimming attainment?	We have offered top-up swimming lessons to all KS2 children who hadn't previously secured their 25m and water safety awards - many of these children have now secured both awards

so won't need to swim with the school next year.

Many year 4, 5 and 6 children who had not secured the water safety awareness award in year 3 have now secured it.
