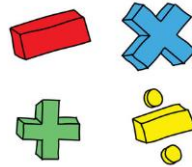


English

We will be basing our English learning on the Macmillan Cancer Charity, as well as linking with our history learning to support our writing. During our English lessons, we will write for a variety of purposes including; persuasive letters of invitation, informative leaflets, diary entries and newspaper reports.

Maths

This term, the children will be developing their place value skills. They will be reading, writing and ordering numbers up to 10000. Following this, the children will be enhancing their addition and subtraction skills through reasoning and problem-solving activities. The children will begin to use Times Tables Rockstars on a regular basis.



History

In history, the topic is the Roman Empire and its impact on Britain. The children will learn about Julius Caesar's attempted invasions of Britain, the pros and cons of being a Roman soldier and how, and why, Boudicca and the Iceni tribe resisted the Romans. Additionally, the children will research about Roman faith.

Science

We will be focusing on Electricity.

PSHE

After discussing class rules and responsibilities, the children will be learning about safe behaviours. They will learn how their behaviour can impact others positively and negatively and why it is not always good to keep a secret.

RE

In R.E. children will be considering what is important to them and what is important to Hindus. They will also be learning about the story of Rama and Sita, and how Hindus worship.

Design and Technology

In D&T, we will be learning the following:

- Design, make and evaluate Roman figurines.
- Design, make and evaluate healthy Roman cookies.



Music

Pupils receive one hour of curriculum music teaching per week delivered by a specialist music teacher. This focusses on four main areas of teaching and learning: singing; composing/improvising; performing and listening.

Pupils in year 4 continue to use recorder to develop instrumental playing and reading skills but we also welcome a Warwickshire Music specialist to deliver ukulele lessons.

PE

The children will be honing their netball skills through practicing: the three types of pass, dodging, finding space, pivoting and shooting with accuracy. They will play a range of small sided games. The children will be learning other ball sports with Go4Goals.
